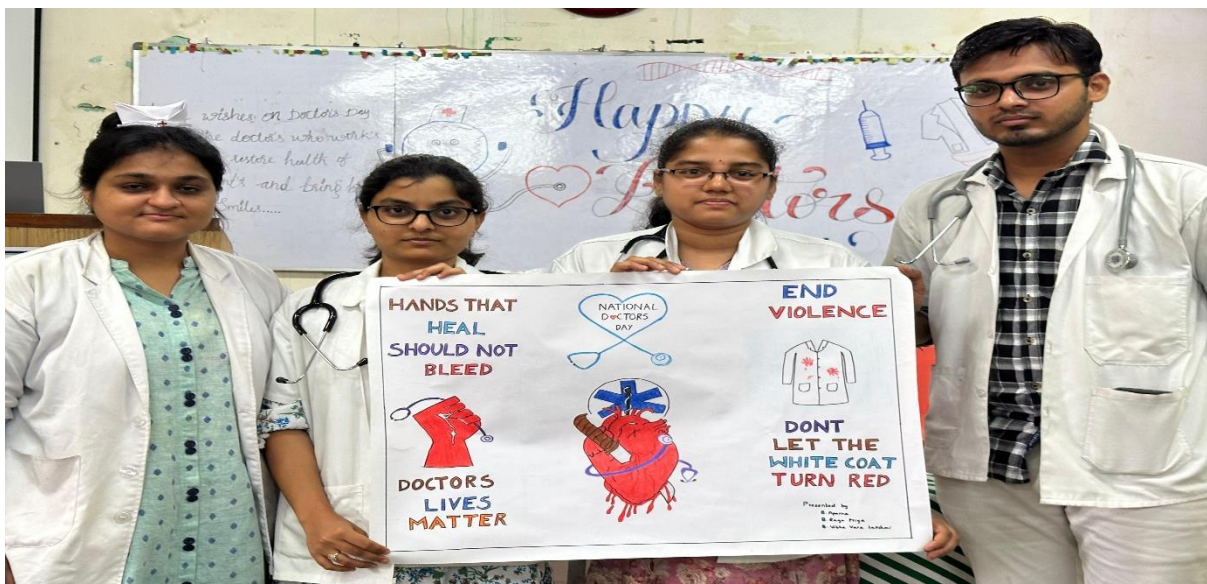
Skit on Violence Against Doctors
