This notification is issued for registration of the candidates appearing for MBBS First Year (New Regulation) Regular Examinations, commencing from 15.02.2023.

1) <u>Eligibility to appear for MBBS First Year (New Regulation) Regular</u> <u>Examinations:</u>

The MBBS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2021-22 whose admissions are approved by the University and students admitted before 2019-20 and opted for new regulation and students who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examination conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examination subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The MBBS First Year students who are having minimum 75% (SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT) attendance and scored minimum 50% (FIFTY PERCENT) marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3) The calculation of the attendance percentage is up to <u>15.01.2023</u>.
- The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks is from <u>17.01.2023</u> to <u>20.01.2023</u>.
- 5) The confirmation date for attendance and internal marks uploaded is <u>23.01.2023</u>.

6) <u>Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without</u> <u>additional answer booklet</u>

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MBBS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
